The bouquet comprises flower scents (violet, peony), fruits (blackcurrant, Morello cherry, quince), animal scents, musk and pepper. A little tannic and a little hard in youth, with age the Fixin acquire a heightened and rounded attack and solid structure. It's fullness is remarkable and it's texture delicate. | 55.00 |

- 94 **Domaine Jean Chauvenet Nuits Saint Georges 2015 – Côte De Nuits, Burgundy, France** 45.00  
A fresh, intense red wine, with aromas and flavours of cherry, liquorice, and balsamic. These wines are approachable in their youth but still with all of the power, concentration and complexity that they have always had.
- 95 **Gevrey-Chambertin Domaine Roux – Burgundy, France** 70.00  
Great red Burgundy like this manages to be both robust and muscular whilst still supple and fragrant. This is a joy!
- 115 **Vougeot 1er Cru ‘Les Petits Vougeots’ 2015** 95.00  
**Domaine Roux Pere et Fils - Burgundy, France**  
This wine is made from Pinot Noir and named after the village of Vougeot in Burgundy. It comes from a special vineyard with Premier Cru status (one level below Grand Cru) called ‘Les Petits Vougeots’. It has vibrant aromas of red cherry with silky liquorice notes and flavours of raspberry jam and cedar.

- 55 **Alto Bajo Merlot – Valle Central, Chile** 20.00  
Merlot is an old French word for ‘blackbird’, so-called because they love these sweet, soft, plummy grapes when they are ripe and ready to make wines like this.
- 56 **Riva Leone Barbera – Piedmont, Italy** 22.00  
Any dishes with lots of tomatoes are perfect for this crisp and fresh red with a bright, cherry fruit.
- 57 **Finca la Estacada Tempranillo 6 Mesas En Barrica D.O. – Ucles, Spain** 23.00  
Elegant Rioja style from the heart of Spain. This is a ripe and juicy Tempranillo from the land of Don Quixote with lovely cream and spice notes from oak ageing. Perfect with lamb.
- 58 **Château L'Eglise – Bordeaux, France** 24.00  
Curranty fruit mingling with lightly spiced, cedar oak and a freshness that makes this perfect with lighter lamb dishes.
- 59 **Château Gardegan Bordeaux Superior – Bordeaux, France** 30.00  
When Sir Nicholas Soames talked about a ‘breakfast claret’ it was probably something like this bright, curranty Bordeaux, perfect with lighter game dishes and simple steaks. Just enough spice and a lovely, light grip on the palate
- 60 **Dinastia Vivanco Rioja Crianza – Rioja, Spain** 30.50  
Elegance and suppleness in a glass, with bright and juicy cherry, currants and vanilla.
- 61 **Côtes du Rhône St Cosme – Rhone, France** 31.00  
This is perfect Cotes du Rhone from the best producer in the Northern Rhone – spiced, minerally and dense. Flavours of graphite, strawberry compote, and lilacs. The nose is incredibly complex, with notes of forest fruits and mint.
- 62 **Plaisir de Château Siaurac Lalande de Pomerol 2013 – Bordeaux, France** 34.50  
Supple, plush and plummy claret with the hallmarks of Lalande de Pomerol mixing red fruit and cherry and a core of lightly peppery currant and cedar oak.
- 63 **Tomàs Cusiné Vilosell – Catalunya, Spain** 34.00  
A wine almost perfectly crafted for game dishes with sweet liquorice and spice in a complex and slightly bonkers blend of grapes.
- 64 **La Croix Bonis de Château Phélan Ségur St-Estèphe 2012 – Bordeaux, France** 40.00  
Compelling and rich, a deeply satisfying, firm red from Bordeaux that makes lamb dishes sing.
- 65 **St Joseph Grand Pompée Paul Jaboulet Aine 2015 – Rhone, France** 45.00  
A smoky, hearty red from the Northern Rhone. Today you will not find better fine wine value than these wines, especially with the dense fruit and peppery spice of a great producer like Paul Jaboulet.

 Very much in the style that Kirwan has favoured over recent vintages, this is a full-bodied, muscular, powerhouse effort. The wine still has a dense ruby/purple colour, with loads of blackberries, cassis, and some noticeable new oak still lingering in the background. Powerful, rich, and full.
- 112 2011 Chateau D'Issan Margaux, 3ème Cru Classé, Bordeaux, France** **95.00**  
 This year d'Issan made a very pretty wine with lovely clarity of expression. The flavours are attractive, offering violets, cassis and ripe, juicy red berries. The palate offers nice concentration of flavours. A balanced and elegant Margaux.
- 128 2013 Chateau Notton, Cht Brane Cantenac, Margaux, France** **55.00**  
 Intense garnet colour with aromas of roasted, coffee, mocha and black fruit.  
 A well balanced, round, rich and generous, underlined with silky tannins  
 A great Margaux produced on Brane-Cantenac - 2eme Cru Classé. Château Notton reveals the finesse and the complexity of Margaux's greatest soils. Henri Lurton and Christophe Capdeville use all their winemaking skills to bring out its best qualities.
