Charles Smith Kung Fu Girl Riesling - Washington, USA

This is possibly the funkiest wine on our list, made by a rock music impresario and it shows in the wine. First impressions white peach, mandarin orange and apricot are delivered with a core of minerality that makes this dry Riesling shimmer with energy and freshness.
