Fresh, appley white from Italy's far north, with a dollop of honey balancing out the crisp acidity of all those fresh green apples.

Brilliant benchmark Chablis with clean, incisive Chardonnay fruit: green apples, hints of honey, lemon and limes, stony minerality and just a whisper of richness behind.	
St Veran Grand Buissieres Vignerons des Terres Secretes Côtes Chalonnaise	45.00
The of vinyard located in the heart of Saint Veran area with a great south sun exposure. Subtle golden colour, this wine has a nice mouth round and full wiht a mineral finish.	
Sancerre Blanc, Le Petit Broux, Cave de Sancerre, Loire, France	45.00

Fruit Driven & Aromatic

Vine Trail Gewürztraminer, Rapel Valley, Chile 25.00
A dry Gewürztraminer, with just a touch of richness; well-balanced showing classic notes of orange blossom, lychee and rose followed by a fresh finish.

Ca' di Ponti Grillo, Sicily 25.00
Full-flavoured, rounded Sicilian white with bags of character - fantastic value for money. A honeyed, floral and spicy nose with hints of ginger and stone fruit. Ripe, sun-dried citrus characters on the palate with savoury notes and a creamy texture. Fresh balancing acidity on the lightly nutty finish.

Osado White Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina 25.00
Much like its red counterpart Malbec grapes are hand-harvested but clusters were pressed softly at very low pressure so that the must did not take on any colour from the skin. It's very fresh on the nose, with aromas of red fruits, currants, strawberries and delicate notes of white flowers. It brings the elegance and freshness of white wine together with the strength and texture of the original grape variety. It's great length is due to its refreshing acidity.

Peregrine Mohua Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand 35.00
Tropical New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc, a bowlful of passion fruit, mango and fresh-cut lime, with summer herbs, pink grapefruit and a curl of lemon zest on the nose.

Jean Biecher Pinot Blanc – Alsace, France 27.50
The forgotten Pinot, and undeservedly so. Soft, lightly peachy and fresh with delicate white flowers, this Alsace Pinot Blanc is beautifully food-friendly and subtle.

Virgen de Galir Maruxa Godello, Valdeorres, Galicia, Spain 29.50
The 20-hectare Virgen de Galir winery in Galicia takes advantage of the schist soils in the valley of the Galir river. At almost 600m altitude the advantage of temperature difference between day and night add to the freshness of this wine. On the nose its intense with white fruit and heaps of minerality. Balanced, fresh and persistent on the palate.

Marmora Vermentino di Sardegna DOC – Sardinia, Italy 27.50
Known as Rolle in the south of France, fresh, salty sea breezes create peachy white fruits, soft and rounded, with a zip of salinity behind. Simply delicious.

Vouvray, Domaine du Vieux Vauvert, Chenin Blanc, Loire Valley, France 28.50
Medium-dry with a lively fresh finish, shows ripe apple, quince, lime, and citrus blossom notes. Made from Chenin Blanc grapes grown in the estate's own vineyards around the village of Vouvray, to the east of the city of Tours; blended under the guidance of Angela Muir MW.

<p>Nederburg The Beautiful Lady Gewürztraminer, Stellenbosch, South Africa</p> <p>The wine takes its name from a description of Ilse Graue, the wife of wine maker Johann Graue, for the gracious sense of hospitality, she brought to Nederburg. Hand-harvested fruit has skin contact for 12 hours to concentrate the aromatic flavours. Reign of Terroir Chenin Blanc, Swartland	25.00
An aromatic wine, with good acidity and elegance surrounding the Chenin's summer fruit salad base. Fresh and flavourful, the silky texture satisfying enough for drinking on its own.	
The Federalist Chardonnay, Mendocino County, California	40.00
The wine offers aromas of ripe fruit over lemon curd and pear. The palate is lush and textured and with cinnamon and cardamom spice. Made in the Mendocino County from lees aged, tank fermented Chardonnay grapes. This wine is aged primarily in a mixture of oak, 35% of the barrels being new. The Hungarian and French oak adds wood and spice whilst the American oak provides a sweetened edge.	
Chablis 1er Cru 'Les Vaillons' Domaine Jean Defaix	65.00
This premier cru is rich with mineral, apple and melon flavours and the waxy texture combined with balanced acidity which shows us how good Chablis can be. The bouquet has a striking smoky, mineral character. The palate shows high acidity, plenty of mineral complexity and a touch of honey. A rich, full style with good acidity.	
Saint-Aubin, Louis Jadot, Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France	80.00
The commune of Saint Aubin lies at the western fringe of the Côte de Beaune overlooking Auxey Duresses, Meursault, Puligny-Montrachet, Chassagne-Montrachet and Santenay. touches of soft peachy fruit and a delicate nutty rounded character on the long-balanced finish.	
Clos de Gat Chardonnay, Israel	80.00
Complex Chardonnay with citrus fruit flavours balanced by judicious use of rich, creamy oak and lees ageing. The 14 ha vineyard in the foothills of the Judean mountains takes its name from a pre-Roman wine press found in the grounds.	
Rully 1er Cru Raborce, Patriarche Père & Fils, Côte Chalonnaise, Bourgogne, France	65.00
this wine is gold flecked with green, and the gold deepens with age. It is redolent with superb aromas of hedgerow flowers (acacia, may, honeysuckle, and a very delicate elderflower) as	

well as violet, lemon, white peach or flint. Time brings out honey, quince, and dried fruits. Indeed, this wine is full of fruit, which on the palate is lively and well-rounded, meaty and long. It has both the coolness and the polish of marble.

Pouilly Fuisse La Croix Vieilles Vignes Denogent, Mâconnais, Burgundy, France 75.00

Utter loveliness. Top-flight white Burgundy from a great small producer who regularly sells out. This family winery is all about minimalism. No chemicals, no synthetics, just years of winemaking heritage in each bottle.

Jordan Russian River Valley Chardonnay – Sonoma County California, USA 110.00

Refined aromas of green apple, pear and lemon peel with a flinty note. Its elegant palate echoes the bouquet with bright flavours of stone fruit and citrus, backed by firm acidity. A touch of creaminess on the mid-palate is followed by lovely mineral notes carrying a long finish. It would be difficult to distinguish this bottle as Californian against a line-up of White Burgundies.

Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Macherelles Domaine Roux 2018 125.00

This wine has aromas of mayflower, acacia and honeysuckle, with verbena, hazelnut and toast. It has a profound flinty minerality, with a persistent finish.

2015 Chablis Grand Cru Blanchot Louis Jadot 95.00

The palate is very well balanced, quite lush in the mouth, with subtle tropical tones that become more obvious toward the peachy, passion fruit finish

2014 Bâtard-Montrachet Grand Cru Louis Jadot 325.00

This is a major wine from a great white wine vintage that's naturally impressive and intense. Ripe white and yellow fruit dominates the palate, sustained by wood aging flavours and tight, nervy texture. Bâtard-Montrachet is largest of the five white Grand Crus in Puligny and Chassagne Montrachet.

Red - Light & Fruity

Bardolino Classico, Bolla, Veneto, Italy	25.00
From vineyards on the shores of Lake Garda, close to Verona. Made using the traditional mix of Corvina, Rondinella and Molinara grapes, cool-fermented to conserve the maximum fruit flavours and aromas, typically light-bodied with a fresh, fruity character.	
Terre di Giumara Frappato Nerello Mascalese IGT – Sicily, Italy	26.50
IGP Terre Siciliane, from Trapani, and a 50/50 blend of Frappato and Nerello Mascalese. Wow - soaring perfume, the wine has a aromas and flavours of jammy red fruits, summer herbs and a touch of violet. On the palate it is rich, yet juicy and refreshing.	
2015 Toscano Rosso, <i>Organic</i>, Tenuta Santa Lucia, Tuscany, Italy	27.50
A beautiful blend of Sangiovese and Ciliegiolo grapes grown in the low-yielding organic vineyard of the Tenuta Santa Lucia on coastal Tuscany, near Light and fruity, a cascade of cherry and raspberry on the tongue plus a whiff of herbs on the nose.

Fleurie Pascal Clemont – Beaujolais, France	29.50
Fresh, attractive, and bright with clean fruit flavours – archetypal Beaujolais, in other words. A striking and vivid red colour with several punnets' worth of red berry fruit on the nose and palate. Soft and fresh with light ripe tannins and crisp acidity.	
'Septembre' Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Edouard Delaunay	39.50
Crimson in colour. The nose is redolent of typical aromas of red and black fruit (raspberry, blackcurrant, cherry). The same black fruit notes are perceived on the palate. The finish is full and fresh.	
Napa Cellars Pinot Noir, California	39.50
Beautiful aromas of black cherry, cola, earth, spice and dark caramel. Abundant flavours of cherry pie, dark fruit, toasted pie crust and dried herbs are framed by rich vanilla notes on the palate. Well structured with a balanced acidity leading to a long and lingering finish. The grapes were sourced exclusively from premier vineyards in the southern part of Napa Valley where the San Pablo Bay creates a cool, maritime climate	
Domaine Lucien Lardy Morgon 2019, Côte du Py, Beaujolais, France	49.50
After an exceptional Beaujolais? Côte du Py makes a claim as the finest vineyard area of Morgon. The Gamay grape loves the granite and clay soils here. We'll spare you the science. But this brings a delicious wine to your glass. Expect notes of cherry, blackberry and oak. Pair this with roast chicken.	
Domaine Roux Santenay 1er Cru Clos Rousseau, Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France	70.00
A dense, bright, dark red with delicious fruit on the nose, this is very classy. The nose is multi-layered with real density. Nor undue weight. Very succulent; a winner this year.	

Prophet's Rock Home Vineyard Pinot Noir, Central Otago, New Zealand 85.00
One of New Zealand's most exciting producers, creating premium, artisan wines in Central Otago, with winemaker Paul Pujol at the helm.
Rich ruby in colour, with red berry fruit, spice and floral aromas on the nose. An elegant, well structured, mineral-driven palate with rich aromatics and silky tannins. This wine will reward cellaring over the next 6-10 or more years from vintage.

Gevrey Chambertin Domaine Roux, Côte de Nuits, Burgundy, France 95.00
Notes of wild strawberry, violet, and rose on the nose. This is a structured Gevrey with velvety tannins and well-judged oak. The palate evokes black cherry and licorice.

Barbera Amonte, Volpi- Piedmont, Italy 25.00
Dark berry fruits with a core of fine tannins and the typical Barbera acidity that makes these wines so perfect to accompany big hearty autumn meals - perfect with pheasant and game

Yellow Label Monastrell, Juan Gil, Jumilla Spain 29.50
The Monastrell grape variety is perhaps best known as Mourvèdre due to it being a component of many a Châteauneuf-du-Pape. It has been farmed in Spanish vineyards for over 500 years, particularly close to the east coast. This rich, fruit-driven example shows the grapes typical savoury, red fruit flavours.

2017 Bordeaux Superieur, Château Camarsac Vieilles Vignes, France 34.50
Warm, spicy Bordeaux, heady with cinnamon and clove, followed by a juicy mouthful of red and black fruit. Perfect with lighter game dishes and simple steaks. Just enough spice and a lovely, light grip on the palate

Côtes du Rhône Rouge, Domaine de la Janasse, Southern Rhône, France 35.00
A fabulous example from the southern Rhône, east of the appellation Châteauneuf-du-Pape, in the city of Courthézon.; filled with spiced black fruit jam and immensely, appealingly concentrated.

Rioja Crianza, Ramón Bilbao, Rioja, Spain 35.00
Rioja from a fabulous producer, full of black fruit plus an intriguing sour note, so that added to the sweetness of blackberries and blackcurrants comes the tang of blackberry yoghurt.

Altos de Jose Ignacio Reserve Tannat 2018 37.50
A juicy wine with fresh aromas of plums, raspberries and spices. It has soft silky tannins to compliment the ripe blackberry and oak flavours on the palate.

Château Lyonnat, Lussac-Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux, France	37.50
Gérard Milhade's principal château and one noted for producing wines of outstanding quality. The blend is 85% Merlot, 11% Cabernet Sauvignon and 4% Cabernet Franc. The estate includes some parcels of old vines and the hillside vineyards are situated on limestone and clay soils. Deep garnet with a warm spiced bread and red fruit character, powerful, yet supple, with vanilla aromas on the finish.	
2016 Chianti Classico Riserva DOCG, Castellani, Tuscany, Italy	35.00
Fine but complex and intense bouquet, starting with floral notes (mainly violet), developing into ripe fruity and vanilla bean notes, to finish with balsamic notes and hints of liquorice. Captivating, soft and velvety, it is soft and elegant on the palate, rich in noble tannins, with a pleasant final smoothness. Another triumph from the Castellani stable.	
Plaisir de Chateau Siaurac, Lalande de Pomerol 2015	45.00
Intense purple colour. Fresh raspberry and cherry flavours, together with a soft touch of vanilla and spices make for a very charming aroma. Round and soft mouth feel, followed by a medium bodied and yet fleshy sensation. Velvety tannins and long fruity finish.	
2017 Château Beaumont, Cru Bourgeois Haut-Médoc	59.50
Located between St Julien and Margaux, Château Beaumont aims to produce a rich and crowd pleasing wine. They have hired consultant Eric Boissenot, a renowned oenologist in Bordeaux who is involved in many estates, in order to do so and the results are promising. Nose full of fresh red and black fruits with subtle hints of spice. The palate is beautifully balanced, with stunning rich black fruits and full, fine and ripe tannins.	
2015 Château Carreyre, Margaux, Bordeaux, France	69.50
This wine comes from a boutique winery established in the great terroir of Margaux. Elegance, finesse and purity typical of the Margaux AOC. Fruit-driven and pure, with a mix of mulberry, red currant and damson plum notes, laced with espresso-tinged toast and backed by light savory hints on the finish. The 60% new wood barrels bring complexity.	
La Croix Bonis de Château Phélan Ségur St-Estèphe – Bordeaux, France	60.00
Compelling and rich, a deeply satisfying, firm red from Bordeaux that makes lamb dishes sing. This wine is classic St Estèphe with rich, blackcurrant fruit on top of a deeply satisfying tannin structure.	
Domaines Barons de Rothschild (Lafite) Légende Pauillac	72.50
Deep purple robe with black hints. The nose is complex and discreet, the bouquet will further develop upon ageing. Swirling of the glass will reveal notes of underwood, spices and pencil lead delicately woven together. Assertive on the palate, this full-bodied wine shows great persistence and rich flavours. With Cabernet and Merlot grapes taken from the vineyards of Lafite and Duhart Milon, this Pauillac is widely considered to be the 'unofficial third wine of Lafite'.	
2014 Blason de l'Évangile, Pomerol	125.00
This is a classic Pomerol from the Lafite stable: a second wine that offers fantastic value for money. There's plush merlot fruit, with spice and a silky tannic backbone offering support. A wine to buy every year, you overlook the 2014 Blason at your peril.	
Château Clarke (Lustrac-Médoc), Bordeaux, France	90.00
The first wine of Edmond de Rothschild, Château Clarke epitomises the attention to detail shown in all they do. Merlot-led, the silky tannins, perfect structure and decadent complexity make this a must-try Bordeaux.	

2010 Château Kirwan 3ème Cru Classé, Margaux, France 125.00
As always, this estate has produced a blockbuster style of Margaux in 2010, with the more masculine side of the appellation providing density, power, big body, loads of fruit, extract and richness. This wine is powerful and concentrated, but by no means excessively extracted. Dense purple, muscular, deep, and impressive, it is a wine that allows for no compromise among wine lovers.

2010 Château Lagrange 3ème Grand Cru Classé, St Julien, France 125.00
The historic Château Lagrange currently work with the renowned Eric Boissenot with the aim to produce what they call "the best wines in the world". They've certainly done well with this St Julien. It expresses ripe blueberry and blackcurrant flavours, with earthy aromas of leather and tobacco from ageing. It's smooth, yet intense on the palate with a great length. Decant for an hour before serving at room temperature with lamb.

Big, Bold & Spicy

La Serre Syrah Vin de Pays d'Oc – Languedoc, France 25.00
Dark, smooth and juicy, we love the blackberries in this wine mixed with a light, sun-ripened spice.

Lorosco Reserva Colchagua Carmenère – Central Valley, Chile 25.00
Love merlot? You will be a sucker for Carmenère, its redcurrant-scented cousin, found almost entirely in Chile. Lightly spiced with a hint of leafy freshness, this is a mid-weight and versatile red.

Pinotage, 'Reign of Terroir', Swartland South Africa 25.00
Good aromatics from the Pinotage's red fruit, a tasty mix of berries and cherries. The palate displays a fresh and fruity succulence of berry fruits with hints of oak and good acidity.

Bodegas Arraez Bala Perdida, Alicante Bouschet, Valencia, Spain 30.00
100% Alicante Bouschet, the name of this wine comes from the David Carradine film "Lost Bullet" as it is a grape variety rarely used on it's on. Jammy aroma's of black and red fruits with rich, heavy mouthfeel and silky tannins.

Woodbridge Cabernet Sauvignon, California, Robert Mondavi 27.50
A blend of 85% Cabernet Sauvignon with 15% of other varieties, mostly Shiraz and Merlot, employed to add complexity and balance to the palate, some ageing in French and American oak barrels also adds to the flavour spectrum. Appealing red and dark berry fruit character reminiscent of cherry and currant, backed by warm vanilla tones on a long smooth finish.

Malbec Cuma Organic Winemakers, El Esteco, Argentina 29.50
Rich, thrilling Malbec, full of black cherries and black plums, topped off with a scattering of spice.

Les Hipsters Barbe, 2016 Côtes du Bourg, Bordeaux Right Bank, France	32.50
Constructed from 80% Merlot, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Malbec, the grapes grown on vines planted on chalky-clay soils overlooking the Gironde. The fermentation is slow and wine aged in French oak, 10% new, for a year. Shows aromas of ripe dark fruit with notes of broom flowers, coconut and brioche, the palate develops savoury blackcurrant flavours.	
JJ Hahn Homestead Stelzer Road Merlot, Barossa Valley, South Australia	32.50
This Merlot is a rich deep purple colour, indicative of the variety, the nose displays welcoming hints of stewed plum, perfumed violet, cinnamon and cassis. The varietal stewed plum, and blackcurrant fill the mouth evenly, with hints of spice such as clove and cinnamon adding interest and complexity. The long persistence of flavour on the finish is supported by the velvety tannins and a fine line of drying acid, giving texture to the palate. The wine is matured in a mixture of French and American oak and a small percentage of Cabernet Sauvignon features in the blend.	
Nederburg The Brewmaster Cabernet Sauvignon, Western Cape, South Africa	35.00
The blend is based on Cabernet Sauvignon (81%) with Merlot (9%), Malbec (6%) and Petit Verdot (4%) adding complexity to the finished wine. The components of the finished wine were aged for up to two years in French oak barrels prior to blending. Concentrated aromas of dark fruit, blackcurrant and cigar box are backed by a full-bodied palate with juicy fruit and savoury notes.	
2018 Old Vine Zinfandel, Bogle Vineyards	40.00
Californian Zinfandel is one of the world's most underrated big reds and this version is silky and luscious, perfumed with raspberry and boysenberry, with black pepper, toasted oak and pipe tobacco on the palate.	
Lafite Rothschild Grande Reserve Los Vascos Cabernet/Carmènère – Chile	45.00
Expressive nose with fruity aromas of ripe cherry, pomegranate, and prunes, followed by notes of liquorice, caramel and walnut skin. Excellent volume, mouth-filling structure, and persistent tannins.	
Rioja Reserva Journey Collection, 2015 Ramón Bilbao	47.50
Mature black and red fruit; plum, cherry and damson with some balsamic and eucalyptus notes. This wine has intensity and balance, soft, round tannins, and a long finish with hints of toast and liquorice. Rioja lovers will not be let down.	
Barbaresco, 2016 Enrico Serafino, Piedmont, Italy	55.00
The village of Barbaresco, two miles north-east of Alba, stands on a ridge overlooking some of the best vineyards in Piemonte; here the Nebbiolo grape makes well-structured wines with velvety palates. Aged for at least 2 years, and for half that time in large oak barrels, this wine has an intense nose of ripe fruit, violets and spice.	
Rioja Gran Reserva, 2010 Sierra Cantabria	75.00
Celebrating their 150th anniversary, Sierra Cantabria are steeped in not just history, but innovation. With such iconic projects under their belt as Numanthia and San Vicente, they have revolutionised Rioja and as such many people revere Marcos Eguren, winemaker, to be the finest Spain has to offer.	

Valpolicella Classico Superiore Seccal 'Ripasso' Nicolis – Veneto, Italy	50.00
Made with Amarone skins to give a dense, sweet fruit, bitter cherry and heady perfume. A real treat and great value. Rounded, medium bodied effort that has plenty of juicy cherry fruit alongside a dark sense of humour. Blackberries, spice, leather and bitter chocolate all have a part to play. A serious but approachable wine with bags of character.	
Garage Wine Co Cabernet Franc Lot #62 – Maipo, Chile	50.00
A very convincing, fresh, expressive bouquet with pure brambly, briary black fruit and freshly tilled earth. The palate is medium- bodied to full with crisp black cherry and blueberry fruit. The tannins are fine and edgy, while the finish is beautifully composed and contains Margaux- like femininity.	
Ebbio Grappolo Intero Langhe Nebbiolo DOC, Fontanafredda – Piedmonte, Italy	49.50
Nebbiolo, Piedmont's royal grape, from the Langhe, dizzyingly fragrant with dried roses and dried geraniums, followed by a soft, full-bodied mouthful of red fruit.	
Barolo DOCG Antario, Piedmont Italy	57.50
Antario Barolo is a classic Barolo made in the Piedmont Region from the Nebbiolo grape. A rich smooth wine with good flavour, style and balance. Deep ruby red with a bouquet of violet, spices and pepper. Great depth of character on the palate with classic damson fruit flavours and a good amount of spice.	
Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Ogier, Rhone Valley, France	70.00
The nose is spicy with surprising floral notes of grass and acacia, evolving onto more classic notes of red berries, menthol brings a beautiful freshness. The attack is ample, with fine tannins and silky length finishing with scents of the 'garrigues'.	
Penfolds Bin 28 Kalimna Shiraz, Australia	60.00
Penfolds is Australia's star winery. A list of its achievements would resemble an epic novel. You can really taste the Aussie sun in this, it's a full bodied, plush Shiraz that's chock full of black jelly bean, red liquorice and redcurrant flavours.	
Har'el Syrah 2014, Clos du Gat, Israel	70.00
This delicious Syrah from Israel is made with 15% Cabernet Sauvignon to create an intense, discreetly oaked red with classic warm, peppery red fruit flavours and aromas. Rich and rounded with a long, lingering finish.	
Amarone della Valpolicella Classico, 2015 Nicolis – Veneto, Italy	90.00
This deep, complex red wine has flavours of flowers and ripe red fruits, accompanied by hints of forest floor and leather. Full-bodied and elegant, this wine has a powerful long finish.	
Brunello di Montalcino, 2014 Bottega – Tuscany, Italy	87.50
Dense, dark cherries and a refined, lingering spice at the heart of this gorgeous Brunello. Made by the most consistent estate in the region, from vineyards overlooking Siena.	
2008 Giuseppe Quintarelli Rosso del Bepi Veneto IGT, Italy	200.00
Rich, textured, racy and complex, the '08 Rosso del Bepi wafts from the glass with an explosion of berries, cherries, and figs, all complemented by incense, tobacco, cigar wrapper, umami and earth. This is an intense, hedonistic wine that earns the Quintarelli name!	

2014 Vietti Brunate, Barolo DOCG, Italy	200.00
Intense ruby red. Dry, with generous body, harmoniously balanced and velvety texture. Classic, ripe red-fruit, long finish, rich and very elegant. Spices, violet, plums and intense tar, very typical for the Brunate vineyard. The wine is aged for 32 months between French oak barrels and Slovenian oak casks, Bottled unfiltered on July 2015.	
2010 Tignanello Piero Antinori	175.00
Humming with energy and life from the very moment you put your nose in the glass, Marchesi Antinori's 2010 Tignanello shows magnificent aromatic layering and an enormous capacity to peel back and reveal itself in beautiful slow motion. This is an articulate wine with a long story to tell about the quality of its profound 2010 fruit.	
2014 Castello di Ama L'Apparita Toscana IGT, Tuscany, Italy	195.00
100% Merlot Deep, impenetrable crimson with violet nuances, red berries, blackberries; spice reminiscent of vanilla, black peppercorns, and juniper. A balsamic note completes the aromatic profile of this wine. Extremely stylish, velvety and mouthfilling, yet powerful, with silky, delicate tannins. Decidedly fresh-tasting, endlessly lingering.
