- 3002 **Pete's Pure Pinot Grigio, South Eastern Australia** 25.00
Aromatic and fresh Australian Pinot Grigio, delicious and refreshing. Honeysuckle, stone fruit and pear flavours on the palate, with a delightful acid backbone and lingering finish.
- 3003 **Muscadet Sevre et Maine sur Lie Les Templiers, Loire Valley, France** 27.50
Lovely and light with aromas and flavours of apples, pears, peaches and figs. The texture has a delicate spritz and the finish is long.
- 3004 **Sauvignon Blanc Les Nuages, Touraine, Loire, France** 28.00
Sancerre for a fraction of the price! Lively Loire Sauvignon with classic minerality, lemon and lime fruit on the nose and palate. Crisp and dry with refreshing, seafood-friendly acidity on the finish.
- 3005 **Marmora Vermentino di Sardegna DOC – Sardinia, Italy** 29.50
Known as Rolle in the south of France, fresh, salty sea breezes create peachy white fruits, soft and rounded, with a zip of salinity behind. Simply delicious.
- 3006 **Mas Puech Picpoul de Pinet, Coteaux du Languedoc, France** 29.50
'Picpoul' means the 'lip-stinger' because of the grape's refreshing zestiness, coupled with a delicious ripe fruit.
- 3007 **Pinot Bianco Alto Adige Alois Lageder – Alto Adige, Italy** 35.00
White flowers, white fruit and a character as crisp and bright as the Dolomite mountains it hails from. Alois Lageder is an ultra-sustainable biodynamic estate established in 1823 and is a true pioneer of biodynamic principals in Italy.
- 3008 **Menetou-Salon, La Bardine, Joseph Mellot, Loire Valley, France** 39.50
The small appellation of Menetou-Salon, just under 500 hectares, is adjacent to Sancerre to the south-west; like its better-known neighbour, it too is planted with Sauvignon Blanc. Here, the vines are planted on Kimmeridgian limestone soils, very similar to those of Chablis, and similar mineral notes can be detected in the wines. Cool-fermented and unoaked, the wine shows fresh citrus fruit, such as grapefruit, green fruit and herbaceous nuances.
- 3009 **Spy Valley Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand** 35.00
Bright and fresh, with aromas and flavours of citrus fruit, peach, and gooseberry. A delicately balanced wine with a refreshing finish.
- 3010 **Chablis Vieilles Vignes, Domaine Paul Nicolle, Burgundy, France** 45.00
Brilliant benchmark Chablis with clean, incisive Chardonnay fruit: green apples, hints of honey, lemon and limes, stony minerality and just a whisper of richness behind.

- 3014 **Ca' di Ponti Grillo, Sicily** 25.00
Full flavoured & rounded with bags of character. A honeyed, floral & spicy nose with hints of ginger and stone fruit. Ripe, sun-dried citrus with savoury notes & a creamy texture.
- 3015 **Osado White Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina** 27.50
Very fresh on the nose, with aromas of red fruits, currants, strawberries and delicate notes of white flowers. It brings the elegance and freshness of white wine together with the strength and texture of the original grape variety. Great length is due to its refreshing acidity.
- 3016 **Cuatro Rayas Verdejo, Rueda, Castilla y Leon, Spain** 27.50
Clean, powerful, and fresh on the nose, the palate is full of fruity, herbal flavours and a touch of fennel on the finish. Full flavoured and powerful, but well balanced with a silky texture and good length.
- 3038 **Marotti Campi Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Superiore Luzano, Marche, Italy** 35.00
Situated near the medieval village of Morro d'Alba on Italy's stunning Le Marche region, they focus on two indigenous varieties: Lacrima and Verdicchio. Aromas of acacia, wildflowers, chamomile, & almonds. Dry and savoury, with a pleasant crisp finish.
- 3017 **Pinot Blanc Jean Biecher, Alsace, France** 29.50
The forgotten Pinot, and undeservedly so. Soft, lightly peachy and fresh with delicate white flowers, this Alsace Pinot Blanc is beautifully food-friendly and subtle.
- 3018 **Vouvray, Domaine du Vieux Vauvert, Chenin Blanc, Loire Valley, France** 29.50
Medium-dry with a lively fresh finish, shows ripe apple, quince, lime, and citrus blossom notes. Made from Chenin Blanc grapes grown in the estate's own vineyards around the village of Vouvray, to the east of the city of Tours.
- 3019 **Riesling, Jean Biecher, Alsace, France** 29.50
This dry white wine is characterised by an intense freshness. It has aromas and flavours of citrus fruit, intertwined with more tropical fruit notes of peach and melon. A medium-bodied wine, with a rich and creamy texture.
- 3020 **Albariño Castelo do Mar, Rias Baixas, Spain** 29.50
Possibly the greatest seafood wine in the world! A fresh bouquet of peach and apricot leading to a rich and full palate with a hint of lemony acidity. Clean and well balanced with a dry, concentrated finish.
- 3021 **Côtes du Rhône Blanc Belleruche, M. Chapoutier, Grenache Blanc, Rhône Valley** 29.50
Bright golden yellow hue. Aromas of apricot, fennel, and floral scents, complex and very elegant. The wine's roundness is a perfect match for its freshness, & the finish reveals subtle notes of aniseed.
- 3022 **Godello, Virgen de Galir Maruxa, Valdeorres, Galicia, Spain** 29.50
Bursting with peaches and pears and lightly scented with flowers. On the nose its intense with white fruit and heaps of minerality. Balanced, fresh and persistent on the palate.

This white is round and fresh all at the same time, with a delicate salinity that flows through the finish - a natural result of the cool sea breeze gently blowing through the vines.

	This superb-value Gruner Veltliner is full of apple peel, hazelnuts, tree resin and lemon aromas, with down-to-earth flavours of earthy minerality, and again apples and pear skin. It has a soft, smooth texture, light tannins, and a refreshing finish.

Fuller Bodied

- 3050 **Rebeland Swartland Chenin Blanc, Swartland, South Africa** 25.00
An aromatic wine, with good acidity and elegance surrounding the Chenin's summer fruit salad base. Fresh and flavourful, the silky texture satisfying enough for drinking on its own.
- 3051 **Mendocino Chardonnay 'The Federalist', California, USA** 35.00
The wine offers aromas of ripe fruit over lemon curd and pear. The palate is lush and textured and with cinnamon and cardamom spice. Made in the Mendocino County from lees aged, tank fermented Chardonnay grapes. This wine is aged primarily in a mixture of oak, 35% of the barrels being new. The Hungarian and French oak adds wood and spice whilst the American oak provides a sweetened edge.
- 3053 **Meiomi Chardonnay, Monterey-Sonoma-Santa Barbara, California, USA** 37.50
A blend of 100% Chardonnay grapes from three distinct vineyard regions, with about a third each coming from Monterey, Sonoma and Santa Barbara. The Monterey fruit contributing ripe stone fruit and a creamy character, the Sonoma grapes bringing crisp apple and a lean minerality and the Santa Barbara grapes bring exotic sweet spice and lively tropical fruit flavours to the blend. Bright, layered with tropical and stone fruit mixing with notes of honey and butterscotch.
- 3054 **2018 Chateau Ste. Michelle, Columbia Valley Chardonnay USA** 37.50
Cool-climate Chardonnay from Washington State, soft with sweet citrus and red apples, uplifted by a fragrant scattering of spice.
- 3055 **Macon Villages 'Les Préludes' Vignerons des Terres Secrètes, Burgundy, France** 35.00
Lusciously balanced and creamy Mâcon, singing with honeysuckle flowers, a beautiful food wine.
- 3056 **St-Veran Grand Buissieres Vignerons des Terres Secretes Côtes Chalonnaise** 39.50
The of vinyard located in the heart of Saint Veran area with a great south sun exposure. Subtle golden colour, this wine has a nice mouth round and full wiht a mineral finish.
- 3052 **Montagny, Joseph Drouhin, Côte Chalonnaise, Burgundy, France** 35.00
Shows a pale-yellow colour with bright reflections. The nose is very floral with aromas of honeysuckle and white hawthorn. Ample in the mouth, of a beautiful roundness, notes of white fruits appear with a peppery finish.
- 3059 **Chablis 1er Cru 'Les Vaillons' Domaine Jean Defaix** 55.00
This premier cru is rich with mineral, apple and melon flavours and the waxy texture combined with balanced acidity which shows us how good Chablis can be. The bouquet has a striking smoky, mineral character. The palate shows high acidity, plenty of mineral complexity and a touch of honey. A rich, full style with good acidity.
- 3057 **Pouilly Fuisse La Croix Vieilles Vignes Denogent, Mâconnais, Burgundy, France** 60.00
Utter loveliness. Top-flight white Burgundy from a great small producer who regularly sells out. This family winery is all about minimalism. No chemicals, no synthetics, just years of winemaking heritage in each bottle.

- 3058 **Rully 1er Cru Rabource, Patriarche Père & Fils, Côte Chalonnaise, Bourgogne, France** 65.00
Gold flecked with green, and the gold deepens with age. It is redolent with superb aromas of hedgerow flowers (acacia, may, honeysuckle, and a very delicate elderflower) as well as violet, lemon, white peach or flint.
- 3060 **Clos de Gat Chardonnay, Israel** 69.50
Complex Chardonnay with citrus fruit flavours balanced by judicious use of rich, creamy oak and lees ageing. The 14 ha vineyard in the foothills of the Judean mountains takes its name from a pre-Roman wine press found in the grounds.
- 3061 **Saint-Aubin, Louis Jadot, Côte de Beaune, Burgundy, France** 69.50
The commune of Saint Aubin lies at the western fringe of the Côte de Beaune overlooking Auxey Duresses, Meursault, Puligny-Montrachet, Chassagne-Montrachet and Santenay. touches of soft peachy fruit and a delicate nutty rounded character on the long-balanced finish.
- 3062 **Jordan Russian River Valley Chardonnay – Sonoma County California, USA** 75.00
Refined aromas of green apple, pear and lemon peel with a flinty note. Its elegant palate echoes the bouquet with bright flavours of stone fruit and citrus, backed by firm acidity. A touch of creaminess on the mid-palate is followed by lovely mineral notes carrying a long finish. It would be difficult to distinguish this bottle as Californian against a line-up of White Burgundies.
- 3063 **2014 Chablis Grand Cru Bougros, Domaine de Vauroux** 95.00
This is quintessential Grand Cru Chablis from an outstanding vintage. Intense and elegant on the nose the palate is immensely concentrated and complex with layers of green apple and restrained minerality. The finish is amazingly long.
- 3064 **2020 Puligny Montrachet 1er Cru La Garenne, Gilles Bouton** 95.00
Premier Cru Chardonnay from a legendary patch of Burgundy, creamy and inviting, offering a mouthful of apple and pear and a bright scattering of lemon juice droplets.
- 3065 **2018 Chassagne-Montrachet 1er Cru Macherelles Domaine Roux** 95.00
